



AuSPEN Research Grant

The Australasian Society of Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (AuSPEN) offers grants to member novice researchers (a clinician who does not have an established research track record or a higher degree in research) to assist them to conduct clinical projects of significance to the field of clinical nutrition. In 2019, two Novice Researcher Project Grants will be offered up to a maximum of \$15,000 each (ex- GST).

There are two stages to the grant applications process:

Stage 1: Calls for Expressions of Interest (EOI) which are assessed by the Grant Sub-Committee overseen by the AuSPEN Scientific Committee (open Friday 5th April; close Monday 20th May 2019, 5pm AEST) Please return all completed forms to admin@auspen.org.au

Stage 2: Successful EOI applicants will be notified by COB Friday 7th June and asked to submit a full grant application (due Friday 16th Aug 2019, 5pm AEST). Grant applicants will be advised of the outcome by Friday 22nd November 2019.
